**ADMINISTRATION OF MULTI-FACTORED ASSESSMENT TOOL (MFAT)**

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent

1. In line with the DepEd Order No. 29, s. 2018 re: Policy on the Implementation of Multi-Factored Assessment Tool, this Division through the Curriculum Implementation Division announces the administration of Multi-Factored Assessment Tool to Grade 1 learners from August 30-September 30, 2024.
2. The assessment aims to identify learners with Special Educational Needs (LSENs), who may need education services and/or medical/allied services; and assists teachers in instructional planning and educational placement of learners.
3. This MFAT is a classroom activity-based assessment covering the five domains of learning: (a) Cognitive, (b) Communication, (c) Socio-Emotional, (d) Psycho-Motor, and (e) Daily Living Skills.
4. The result of the MFAT does not in any way, affect the performance of the learners. If the intervention made in the school did not make improvement and/or in the academic functioning of the learner, the school may refer the learner to an allied- medical specialist for further assessment.
5. Schools are encouraged to give their full support to their teachers who will conduct the assessments and intervention/remediation to learners.

7. Expenses relative to the conduct of the above-mentioned activity and the intervention program such as but not limited to the provision of intervention materials shall be charged against school MOOE funds, subject to usual budgeting, accounting, and auditing rules and regulations.
