DIVISION CELEBRATION OF NATIONAL TECH-VOC DAY 2024

1. Pursuant to Republic Act No. 10970, s. 2018 an Act declaring August 25 of every year as National Tech-Voc Day, and DM-CT- 2024-279 re 2024 National Tech-Voc Day, this Office through the Curriculum Implementation Division, Instructional Management Section encourages public and private elementary and secondary schools to observe the 2024 National Tech-Voc Day with the DepEd's theme: "Tech-Voc Tungo sa Pag-unlad at Pagbangon; Angking Talino at Kakayaahan, Linangin at Isulong.
2. The purpose of this celebration is to emphasize the importance of technical-vocational education through providing a platform for the exchange of information, updates and sharing of best practices related to technical-vocational education programs. It also serves to promote and raise awareness of the various technical-vocational education offerings available in schools such as Edukasyong Pantahanan at Pangkabuhayan/ Technology and Livelihood Education (EPP/TLE), Senior High School Technical Vocational Livelihood (SHS-TVL) Track, Maritime, Work Immersion Program, Special Program in Technical-Vocational Education (SPTVE), and Rural Farm Schools (RFS).
3. The activities will be held from Aug. 21 to Aug. 31, 2024. All schools are encouraged in coordination with other relevant government agencies and partner industries to organize activities such as forums, seminars, mentoring sessions, skills showcase, mini courses for parents, teachers, and school employees, product and services display showcase, job fair and other related advocacy activities.
4. As stipulated in DepEd Order No.9, s. 2005 on Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged-Time-on-Task and in adherence to the provisions of Deped Order No. 003, s. 2023, titled Amendment to Deped Order No. 022, s. 2023 (Implementing Guidelines on the School Calendar and Activities for the School Year 2023-2024), and DepEd OASGFO Memorandum No. 2022-058 with the subject Request for the Participation of Learners and Teachers in Extra-Curricular Activities, classes should not be disrupted. The celebration should leverage the time allotted for subjects like EPP/TLE/TVL/SPTVE in preparation for and during the event.

2024 NATIONAL TECH-VOC DAY

To **Schools Division Superintendents**

1. In reference to DM-CT-2024-279 titled “2024 National Tech-Voc Day,” this Office through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) shall conduct the Regional celebration of National Tech-Voc day with the theme **“Tech-Voc Tungo sa Pag-Unlad at Pagbangon; Angking Talino at Kakayahan, Linangin at Isulong.”** The activity will be hosted by SDO Cavite Province on August 30, 2024. Specific venue shall be announced through an Advisory.
2. The objectives of this celebration are to: (a) emphasize the importance of technical-vocational education by providing a platform for exchange of information, updates and sharing of best practices, and (b) promote awareness of various tech-voc offerings available in schools such as Edukasyong Pantahanan at Pangkabuhayan (EPP), Technology and Livelihood Education (TLE), Technical-Vocational-Livelihood (TVL), Special Program in Technical-Vocational Education (SPTVE), Maritime and Rural Farm School.
3. Schools division offices and schools are encouraged to conduct a one (1) day celebration of “Tech-Voc day” starting from August 19 to 31, 2024. Activities such as forums, seminars, mentoring sessions, skills showcase, mini-courses for parents, teachers, and school employees, product and services display, job fair and other related advocacies may be conducted.
4. Enclosed in this Memorandum are the following:
 - a. Number of expected participants with provision of meals,
 - b. Schedule of Activities; and
 - c. Assignments of SPTVE and SHS with TVL offerings / SDOs.
5. For the conduct of the Regional Tech-Voc day celebration, provision of meals, supplies and materials of the 150 participants shall be charged against the downloaded funds; while their travelling expenses shall be charged against

their local funds subject to usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

SDOs may invite not more than five (5) School Heads to conduct benchmarking. Their meals and travelling expenses shall be charged against their local funds subject to usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
