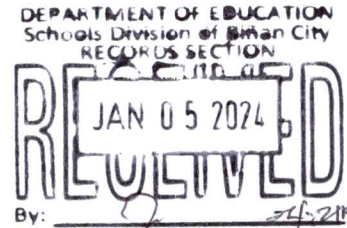

CONDUCT OF CLUSTER SPORTS MEET 2024

1. Pursuant to Republic Act No. 10588, Section 2, which provides that it is the policy of the State to promote physical education and encourages sports program, league competitions and amateur sports, including training for international competitions, to foster self-discipline, teamwork, and excellence for the development of healthy and alert citizenry, this Office, through the School Governance and Operations Division (SGOD), announces the **Conduct of Cluster Sports Meet 2024 on January 13 and 14, 2024**

2. This activity aims to:

- nurture a healthy spirit of competition, sportsmanship and teamwork;
- expose students to leisure activities that will contribute to an active lifestyle and enhance physical fitness;
- provide opportunities to practice and internalize the skills, attitudes and knowledge acquired in the delivery of physical education competencies.

4. The following sports events will be played during this Cluster Meet:

- Basketball (Boys and Girls; Elementary and Secondary)
- Basketball 3x3 (Boys and Girls; Secondary)
- Chess (Boys and Girls; Elementary and Secondary)
- Sepak Takraw (Boys and Girls; Elementary and Secondary)
- Table Tennis (Boys and Girls; Elementary and Secondary)
- Volleyball (Boys and Girls; Elementary and Secondary)

5. All winners with qualified coach/es in the above-mentioned sports events will proceed to the Division Athletic Sports Meet, in addition to the athletes of the remaining sports events which were not included in the Cluster Meet.

6. Submission of non-negotiable documentary requirements in this Cluster Meet to the Cluster designated Screening Committee is required:

- Original PSA Birth Certificate
- Athlete Record
- Parental Consent
- Medical History Form 2 (Should there be any questions to the completed and signed Medical History Form 2, the screening committee shall refer it to the Division Medical Officer)
- Athlete Gallery
- Coach Record with attached training

7. For an **elementary athlete, the cut-off age/year is 13 years old or must have been born on or after January 1, 2011**; and for a **secondary athlete, the cut-off age is 18 years old or must have been born on or after January 1, 2006**. Athletes born before said date shall be immediately disqualified from the Division, Regional, and Palarong Pambansa.

8. Any misrepresentation and/or willful fraud to the documents submitted shall be a ground to disqualification for the game and the upper meets.

9. Relative to the Cluster Meet, a **coordination meeting, with the school heads and school sports coordinators** shall be held on **January 8, 2024, Monday**. In the event that the school head or sports coordinator will not be able to attend, a representative is highly encouraged.

10. Schools are expected to adhere with the no disruption of classes or time on task policy of the Department.

11. The conduct of these sports activities should be in adherence to the provisions of the Child Protection Policy.

12. All activities should be structured to ensure that safety requirements are met including the consideration of each child's readiness for the activity based on age, skill, and physical condition.

13. All activities should be supervised to ensure safety and orderly progression of each event.

14. Immediate first aid must be available from trained providers any time the program is in progress.

15. Strict adherence to the no collection policy is expected. Extravagant expenses for costumes/uniforms and the likes are highly discouraged.

16. All sports event to be played shall be governed by Palarong Pambansa Guidelines, Rules and Procedures.

17. For team sports, the **winner take all policy** shall be applied in representation of teams (school sports clubs) to the Palarong Pambansa

18. Measurable sports such as athletics, swimming and archery shall adopt the **qualifying distance, time and points** set by the Palarong Pambansa.

19. A narrative report of the conduct of cluster meet shall be submitted to the SDO (SGOD Office) **on January 19, 2024**.
20. Teaching personnel who will render services during weekends shall be given Service Credits and Compensatory Overtime Credits (COC) for the non-teaching personnel based on the actual services rendered prior to and during the sports activities.
21. Expenses relative to the conduct of these activities shall be charged against School MOOE, canteen fund, and other school funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
