CORRIGENDUM AND ADDENDUM TO DIVISION MEMORANDUM NO. 175, S. 2021 RE: SEARCH FOR HERITAGE TREES IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS

1. Relative to Division Memorandum No. 175, s. 2021 and OUA MEMO 00-0621-0093, this Office informs the field on the **Corrigendum and Addendum on the Search for Heritage Trees in Public Schools**.
 2. Guidelines for this activity are as follows:
 - a. Measure of Girth
The girth should be measured at a height of 1.5 meter above the ground or 1.5 meter above the highest point of the surrounding ground (if the ground is uneven). A leaning or collapsed tree should be measured on its lower side.
 - b. CENRO Certification
Present the testimony/ies and the reference for the basis of the tree being considered as native, endemic, exotic, rare, threatened, and endangered.
 - c. Entry
One teaching or non-teaching personnel, one entry of heritage tree per school. The Division will choose the finalist per school (if there are many submissions) which will be endorsed to the Regional Office.
 - d. Computation for the Age of the Tree
Testimonies will be used instead of the formula, since there is no standard computation for the age of a tree.
 - e. Certificate
All schools with entries will receive a certificate to be released by the Division Office (regardless if they are endorsed or not to the Regional Office).
 3. Requirements:
 - a. Selfie with the heritage tree and picture of the tree being measured;
 - b. Minimum girth of 1 meter;
 - c. Testimonials on the age of the tree;
 - d. CENRO Certification;
 - e. Brief history of the tree (maximum of one page);
 - f. Reference/citation for the basis of the heritage tree being considered as native, endemic, exotic, rare, threatened, and endangered.
 4. Deadline of submission is **on or before June 18, 2021** thru this link:



The Office of the Undersecretary for Administration (OUA) through the Bureau of Learner Support Services – Youth Formation Division (BLSS-YFD) will revive the accounting and inventory of heritage trees in all public schools nationwide to intensify the preservation of the country's biodiversity.

In this regard, the **Search for Heritage Trees in Public Schools** will be conducted on **16 June 2021** as part of the International Day for Biological Diversity. This year's theme is *We're part of the solution #ForNature*.

All eligible school heads as well as teaching and non-teaching personnel may participate in the said activity. The top 10 winners will receive a pair of shoes, laptop bag, and flash drive.

The following are the requirements for submission of entries:

1. selfie with the heritage tree (heritage tree refers to any healthy native or endemic, exotic, rare, threatened, and endangered tree with a minimum girth of five [5] meters);
2. picture of the tree itself;
3. certificate for the age of the tree from the local Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR); and
4. brief history of the tree (maximum of one page).
