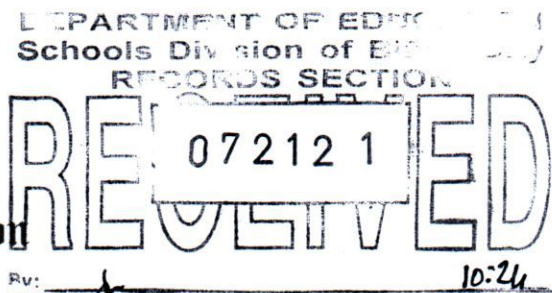

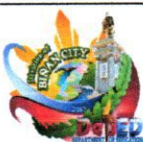

1. By virtue of Section 7 of the Presidential Decree No. 491 entitled "Nutrition Act of the Philippines, 25 June 1974" the Nutrition Month is celebrated every July which aims to increase awareness on the importance of proper nutrition.
