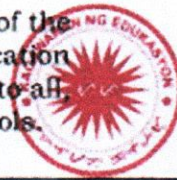
**Subject: ONLINE CELEBRATION OF THE

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NATIONAL DISASTER RESILIENCE MONTH (NDRM) CELEBRATION July 2021

Theme: Tamang Pamamahala't Kahandaan, Kaalaman at Pagtutulungan sa Sakuna at Pandemya'y Kalasag ng Bayan

I. Rationale

National Disaster Resilience Month (NDRM) is celebrated every July through Executive Order No. 29 to promote awareness and disaster resilience. As the world continues to respond to COVID-19, there is no better day to be involved than now.

Prevention saves lives. Even when we are in the middle of a pandemic, our mission to make our communities more resilient continues. While COVID-19 has led to various disruptions to our daily routines, it has provided us with an opportunity to re-evaluate how we handle disaster responses and how we can make our systems more effective for the benefit of our nation.

This year's National Disaster Resilience Month (NDRM) Celebration is marked with the theme, ***"Tamang Pamamahala't Kahandaan, Kaalaman at Pagtutulungan sa Sakuna at Pandemya'y Kalasag ng Bayan."*** The observance emphasizes the important role of disaster risk governance and the collaboration of all Filipinos to overcome this pandemic's challenges and build a green and resilient normal.

With the realization that children are the most vulnerable during disasters, it is indeed our responsibility to strengthen their participation in disaster management decisions. Their involvement in those decisions can also ensure the realization of other child rights enshrined by the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child, including the right to safety, survival, protection from violence and harm, adequate health care, and education, all of which are compromised in the event of a disaster.

Children have a unique perspective on disaster risks that can improve a community's overall resilience to disasters, and they are effective communicators of risk to each other and their communities. With this, the Department of Education (DepEd), through the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Service (DRRMS) in partnership with SAVE the Children Philippines, with the support of the Youth Formation Division (YFD), and Public Affairs Service (PAS), will conduct an online NDRM Celebration focusing on children and youth participation in DRRM.

I. Objectives

The NDRM Celebration aims to

1. Increase awareness of the basic education sector on disaster preparedness.
2. Increase participation of learners and DepEd personnel in addressing disaster preparedness.
3. Increase recognition of the 'Ready Kid' mascot and puppet as the face of resilient learners and promotion of the 'Laging Handa' jingle to help raise awareness on disaster preparedness.

DIGITAL POSTER MAKING CONTEST

Mechanics

1. The contest is open to Elementary and Secondary learners.
2. The contest revolves around the National Disaster Resilience Month theme: "Tamang Pamamahala't Kahandaan, Kaalaman at Pagtutulungan sa Sakuna at Pandemya'y Kalasag ng Bayan".
3. Only one (1) entry per school in elementary and secondary level is allowed in this competition. Entries must be sent in A4 size (portrait or landscape) in JPEG/PNG format via email address (ernane.escuvania001@deped.gov.ph) on or before August 6, 2021. Official entry must include the entry form with the complete name of the contestant, complete address, contact numbers along with the one-page description of the poster (see attachments below)
4. Participants may use any Editing software (photoshop, paint, etc.)
5. Any artwork in the poster must be in original design. Poster designs containing clip-art will not be considered by judges.
6. A one-page explanation and description of the artwork (in English or Filipino) for at least 200 words must be attached on a separate sheet upon submission of the entry. The composition must be encoded in an A4 size paper.
7. The qualified digital poster entries will post on Deped Binan City DRRM FB page. Like accumulated for each entry will have a bearing on the total score and will only be valid if the likers were able to like the Deped Binan City DRRM Official Facebook page.
8. The criteria for judging are as follows:

• Theme Relevance	30%
• Originality	25%
• Aesthetic Appeal	20%
• No. of likes on Deped Binan City DRRM FB Page	15%
• Description of artwork/poster	10%
TOTAL	100%
9. The posters which attained the highest average ratings will be proclaimed as winners. The judges will select 3 winners from elementary and 3 from secondary from all the entries submitted and accorded with the recognition awards.
10. The winners will be announced in DRRM FB page. Awards of recognition will be claim at SGOD office until further notice.
11. Decision of the board of judges is final and irrevocable.

(Special award) People's Choice Award

The entry who will garner the highest number of Likes will win the People's Choice Award. Likes will only be valid if the likers were able to like the Deped Binan City DRRM FB page. Final counting of likes will be on August 13, 2021 at 12:00 noon.
