
**ACTIVITIES FOR THE SCIENCE CLUB MONTH CELEBRATION**

1. In support of the celebration of National Science Club Month under Presidential Proclamation No. 264, s. 2002, and as the initial implementation of Project MAHOUSE SCIE (Maximizing Assistance and Household Opportunities in Uplifting Students' Enthusiasm in Science) of the Curriculum Implementation Division, this Office announces the conduct of different activities in September that are focused on the theme, "Agham, Pananaliksik, at Teknolohiya, Kabalikat sa Matatag na Pamayanan". The celebration will be highlighted with the election of School Science Club Officers and awarding of winners during the closing program on September 30, 2021.
2. The activities aim to:
  - a. celebrate September as the National Science Club Month,
  - b. provide learning opportunities for teachers and learners through healthy science competitions,
  - c. provide the parents and other household members in promoting science advocacies by supporting their children in different contests,
  - d. elect the schools' Science Club officers who will help promote the importance of science clubbing in the new normal.
4. All learners in public schools are encouraged to join the contests which include Video Making, Poster Making, and Public Speaking. All schools are encouraged to hold a school level competition to maximize participation and conduct the election of Science Club officers. **Contest Mechanics**

**A. Poster Making Contest**

Guidelines:

1. The contest is open to all public schools Biñan City
2. Each school should submit **ONE** entry only.
3. The poster must illustrate, interpret and emphasize the theme of the Science as stated.
4. The following materials will be used in the contest:
  - $\frac{1}{4}$  illustration board (white background & vertical format)
  - Mongol pencil (to be provided by the contestant)
  - Coloring material: oil pastel/craypas, markers, ink, mixed media, oil, acrylic and watercolor (to be provided by the school or the contestant)
5. Use of other materials not specified above is strictly prohibited.
6. Posters must be done in free hand. The artist will be held accountable to any issues that may arise with regards to the originality and authenticity of the design.
7. The posters will be judged according to the following criteria:
  - creativity and presentation (40%)
  - originality (30%)
  - relevance to the theme (30%)

**B. Video Making Contest**

Guidelines

1. The contest is open to all public schools in SDO of Biñan City
2. The video may be in a form of documentary, short story, music video and the like.
3. This should cover any MELC in the grade level Science where the contestants are in.
4. Entries from Elementary contestants are in **Filipino and English** for Junior and Senior HS.
5. The video may be made by 1 to 3 student participants. (maximum of 3) in a MP4, or MOV formats.
6. Each school should submit **ONE** entry only.
7. Entries will be judged based on the following criteria
  - Content (30%) comprehensive, technically correct and easy to understand
  - Impact (20%) the video should have a powerful effect to the target audience
  - Relevance (20%) The video must be relevant to the theme
  - Creativity and Originality (30%) The video must be original and visually stimulating.

**C. Public Speaking**

Guidelines

1. The contest is open to all public schools in SDO of Biñan City
2. The contestant should prepare a 5-minute presentation focused on the theme.
3. There shall be only one representative from the school.
4. The medium is Filipino for Elementary and English for Junior and Senior HS
5. The presentation will be judged based on the following criteria.



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
**A. Presentation**

- Vocal Delivery 20%
- Manner of Speaking 30%

**B. Content**

- Originality 30%
- Organization 20%
