- iii. have rendered at least five (5) years of service with the Department and has at least two (2) years of Very Satisfactory (VS) performance rating;
- iv. **has not earned any units in Master's Degree nor enrolled in any graduate course;**
- v. have no pending nomination for scholarship in another program/course or have already rendered the required service obligation for a scholarship previously enjoyed
- vi. be in good health certified a local government physician;

- viii. have no pending administrative, civil, or criminal case; and
- ix. have not been found guilty of any violation involving moral turpitude, corruption or fraud.



- a. Updated Personal Data Sheet;
- b. IPCRF for the last two (2) years;
- c. Letter of Intent to apply for the scholarship;
- d. Endorsement from the School Head; and
- e. Statement of PRESENT actual Duties and responsibilities RELEVANT to the course signed by the immediate supervisor (1 original, 1 certified copy)

5. Shortlisted participants will undergo evaluation to be conducted by the Human Resource Development Committee (HRDC) of the Division. List of successful nominees shall be endorsed to NEAP-RO for interview.


