3. The participants in this activity are all teaching and non-teaching personnel and learners via online platforms and video presentations.
4. The kick-off event will take place on November 5, 2021, at 9:00 AM through a recorded video presentation to be aired on Facebook live streaming. Guidelines for the Different Competitions

ELEMENTARY LEVEL

A. POEM (TULA) COMPETITION MECHANICS

1. The competition is open to all public Kinder learners enrolled for the SY 2021-2022.
2. Poem shall be recorded prior to the contest and in line with the theme.
3. There shall only one choice of poem to be used in the contest.
4. This competition is designed for each entry to articulate the poem revolving the theme.
5. Sequence order shall be by draw lots to be done before the competition.
6. Punctuality is strictly observed.
7. The decision of the judges is final and irrevocable

Criteria for Judging

Concept Interpretation	- 50%
Execution	- 50%
Total:	100%

CONCEPT INTERPRETATION – 50%

-Demonstrate complete understanding of poem relevance to the theme.

EXECUTION – 20%

- Demonstrate confidence during the presentation.
- The poem was successfully executed from concept to completion, with a novel and original approach.

COSTUME – 10%

1. Use of low cost and indigenous materials are highly appreciated and encourage.

STAGE PRESENCE – 20%

1. The presenter has a superior stage presence with outstanding facial expression and body movement.
2. Attentiveness and enthusiasm perceived through presentation.



B. POSTER MAKING CONTEST

- a. The competition is open to all public Grade 1 to 6 learners enrolled for the SY 2021-2022.
- b. The poster must illustrate, interpret and emphasize the theme of Filipino Values Month entitled “ Pagpapaunlad ng Pagkatao, Pakikipagkapuwa at Pananampalataya, Hamon sa Panahon ng Pandemya”.
- c. The following materials will be used in the contest:
 - a. $\frac{1}{4}$ Illustration board (white background and vertical format) and pencil.
(to be provided by the contestant)
 - b. Coloring material: oil pastel / craypass, marker, watercolor, mixed media, ink (to be provided by the contestant). Use of other materials not specified is strictly prohibited.
- d. The decision of the judges is final and irrevocable

CRITERIA FOR JUDGING

a. Creativity and presentation	40%
b. Originality	30%
c. Relevance to the theme	30%
TOTAL	100%

C. VIRTUAL QUIZ BEE

- a. The competition is open to all public Elementary Grade 6 learners enrolled for the SY 2021-2022.
- b. The coverage of the quiz bee includes lessons and topics of Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao subject from Grade 4-Grade 6.
- c. Open to all Grade 6 students. Each school must have an elimination round and who wins in school based will be the representative in Division level.
- d. The Online Quiz Bee will be held on November 22, 2021 via google meet at 1:00PM. Participants must enter the google meet 30 minutes before the scheduled time.
- e. Participants will have to use either one of the following: desktop, laptop, tablet, or cellphone. Participants must have their own internet or data connection and must have their camera and microphone open throughout the quiz bee.
- f. Prepare an illustration board and chalk or maybe a white board and a Pentel pen for them to use in writing their answers during the quiz.
- g. The quiz bee has three rounds; EASY, AVERAGE, and DIFFICULT. Below are the corresponding number of items, points and time allotment for answering each item.
- h. The decision of the judges is final and irrevocable

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MECHANICS

A. DIGITAL POSTER MAKING CONTEST

1. The competition is open to all public Junior High School learners enrolled for the SY 2021-2022.
2. There will be one representative per school.
3. Each participant should submit ONE entry only.
4. The poster must illustrate, interpret, and emphasize the theme and must adhere to the objectives of the celebration.
5. The use of Canva application is encouraged to be used by the participants in creating the poster.
6. Participants may use any editing software (Adobe Photoshop, Paint, Microsoft PowerPoint, etc.) Other apps may be used. Indicate references
7. The poster shall possess the following specifications:
8. The size of the poster must be in an A4 size (8.27" x 11.69") 300 DPI, in a PORTRAIT format
9. Digital posters CANNOT contain grabbed photos online. Entries shall have original designs and layout made by the participant only. Failure to comply will lead to disqualification.

Criteria for judging:

Content	- 40%
Originality	-20%
Design and Layout	-40%

B. VIRTUAL QUIZ BEE

Mechanics:

1. The competition is open to all public Junior High School learners enrolled for the SY 2021-2022.
2. Each school must have one (1) participant from **Grade 10**.
3. The contest will be held via Google Meet. The participants will use **white board and marker** or **1/8 illustration board and chalk** for their answers.
4. The contest shall be conducted into three (3) rounds: EASY, AVERAGE, AND DIFFICULT.
5. Each team is given 5 seconds to answer for EASY and AVERAGE rounds and 10 seconds for the DIFFICULT.
6. After the given time limit for each question, each participant will have to wait for the go signal given by the Quiz Master before they show their answer on the screen.
7. The Board of judges will determine the finality and veracity of the answer.
8. Each question will have a corresponding point.

SCORING MECHANICS:

1. The contest shall follow a point system of scoring.
EASY ROUND – 1 POINT
AVERAGE ROUND – 3 POINTS
DIFFICULT ROUND – 5 POINTS
2. The participant with the highest score will be declared as the winner. The next two highest scoring participants shall be declared First and Second Runners up respectively.
3. In case of a tie, a clincher will be asked and is worth 1 point.



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C. SPOKEN WORD POETRY

Guidelines and Mechanics

1. Each Junior High School will have one (1) participant to represent their school.
2. The spoken word poetry must be an original composition. It could be written in English or Filipino and must be delivered from memory with movements or gestures related to the piece.
3. Each contestant must submit a pdf copy of the piece. The piece shall have the following specifications:
 - A. Font size is 12
 - B. Font Type: Arial
 - C. One-inch margin all sides
 - D 1.5- line spacing and 0 pt. before and after
 - E. Stanzas are separated with one space in between 3-5 minute recorded video of the delivery of the piece must be submitted to the organizers on or before November 15, 2021. (School Based)
4. The piece must be related to the theme and must not contain any malicious and offensive content.
5. Sounds, instruments, or musical background is allowed to complement the delivery. No deduction shall be made if the contestant opts not to have a musical background.

Criteria for Judging

- a. Message/Content - 40%
 - The content of the spoken piece is relevant to the theme.
 - The piece has a powerful and meaningful message to the audience.
- b. Delivery and Performance- 40%
 - The spoken piece is delivered from the heart.
 - Facial expression, hand and body gestures that emphasize the different elements of the performance.
- c. Originality- 20%
 - The piece must be an original composition by the contestant.



SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL LEVEL

A. SPOKEN WORD POETRY OR PAGBIGKAS NG SALITANG

1. Isa (1) kalahok lamang sa bawat paaralan ang maaring maging kalahok sa patimpalak na ito.
2. Binibigyan lamang ng tatlo(3) hangang limang (5) minuto ang bawat kalahok upang i-video ang pagbigkas ng sarili nilang inihandang piyesa. Sa bawat minutong labis o kulang ay isang puntos ang magiging kabawasan sa pinal na iskor.

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A. DIGITAL POSTER MAKING

Guidelines and Mechanics

1. Each Senior High School will have one (1) participant to represent their school.
2. Each participant should submit ONE entry only.
3. The poster must illustrate, interpret, and emphasize the theme and must adhere to the objectives of the celebration.
4. The use of Canva application is encouraged to be used by the participants in creating the poster.
5. Participants may use any editing software (Adobe Photoshop, Paint, Microsoft PowerPoint, etc.) Other apps may be used. Indicate references
6. The poster shall possess the following specifications:
 - The size of the poster must be in an A4 size (8.27" x 11.69") 300 DPI, in a PORTRAIT format
7. Digital posters CANNOT contain grabbed photos online. Entries shall have original designs and layout made by the participant only. Failure to comply will lead to disqualification.

Criteria for judging:

- A. Content - 40%
 - The poster has a clear structured message or statement that is relevant to the theme
- B. Originality - 20%
 - The work must be original.
- C. Design and Layout - 40%
 - The poster is exceptionally attractive in terms of design, layout and neatness.
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B. VIRTUAL QUIZ BEE

MECHANICS:

1. Each school will be represented by one (1) participant
2. Each participant must have ...
 - a) White board or a $\frac{1}{4}$ illustration board and chalk,
 - b) Pen (for white board)
 - c) Eraser (for white board)
 - d) Blue small flaglet/triangle shaped paper or cloth on a stick)
3. Participants will be given five (5) seconds to answer each question
4. If ready for their answer, the participants must raise the blue flaglet
5. The Quiz Master after five (5) seconds will check that all blue flaglets were raised by all the participants
6. The Quiz Master will then check each participant's answer
7. Participants who answered the most correct answers will qualify for the next round
8. The competition will have three (3) rounds
 - a) Easy
 - b) Average
 - c) Difficult
9. All answers are equivalent to one (1) point
10. Questions will start from 3 EASY questions
11. After three (3) rounds of easy questions the one with the highest score will qualify to answer the three AVERAGE questions .
12. After three (3) rounds of average questions the one with the highest score will qualify to answer DIFFICULT questions .
13. In case of a tie, a tie breaker question will be given
14. A winner/champion will be declared.



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
