All School Heads

1. In pursuant to DepEd Order No. 28, series of 2018 "Policy and Guidelines on Oplan Kalusugan sa Department of Education (OKD) this Office through the School Governance and Operations- School Health Section is hereby disseminating information on the designated School OKD Coordinators and their respective duties and responsibilities. See attached annexes.
2. This information aims to:
 - a. ensure that school heads and their designated coordinators are aware of their duties and responsibilities
 - b. address OKD Program issues and concerns of schools for immediate intervention and assistance thru the SGOD – School Health Section.
 - c. facilitates smooth communications and accuracy of information
3. The School OKD Program Coordinators are expected to perform their duties and responsibilities stated in Annex B. The alternates are expected to perform the duties and responsibilities in the absence of the school coordinators aside from helping when needed.
4. The designated school OKD Program coordinator shall render service for at least 3 years or more depending on the agreement of the school head and the personnel. A justification letter is required from the School Head if the coordinator will be replaced within 3 years of service and to be submitted at the School Health Section.

HEALTH AND NUTRITION COORDINATOR

1. Facilitate the creation of school TWG for Oplan Kalusugan sa DepEd (OKD)
2. Coordinate with the school TWG and prepare a school Action Plan for OKD including the SDHCP services and ensure its integration in the School Improvement Plan (SIP).
3. Forge partnership with potential stakeholders and in the community to support and assist the effective and efficient program implementation.
4. Network with and engage available and interested parties within their locality who shall participate in the program.
5. Ensure proper coordination and active engagement in areas where there are LGUs and/or NGOs/CSOs that are willing to partner for OKD.
6. Identify and prepare the needed resources and facilities in the conduct of the program and source out funds, manpower and other resources.
7. Collaborate with the school TWG to ensure effective implementation of the OKD and program activities in the school setting.
8. Coordinate with the Division OKD Coordinator for the provision of health and nutrition services.
9. Conduct orientation of the program among teachers, partners and other stakeholders with the technical supervision of the SDO aligned with DO 14 s. 2020
10. Participate in the capacity building, seminars, meetings conducted by the SDO.
11. Mobilize the teachers, parents, community members, partners and other stakeholders to support the program and in the distribution of health care supplies, from school to learner's household.
12. Assists OKD program coordinators and act as alternate during their absence.
13. Oversee effective implementation of OKD programs and other service delivery.
14. Implement programs other than 6 pillars of OKD Programs as required e.g School Immunization Program, COVID-19 vaccinations, Infectious Disease Surveillance Reporting etc.

17. Submit Program Terminal Report to the SDO at the end of the school year.



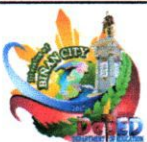

- 5.** Participate in the capacity building, seminars, meetings conducted by the SDO.
- 6.** Mobilize the teachers, parents, community members, partners and other stakeholders to support the program.
- 7.** Ensure proper coordination and active engagement in areas where there are LGUs and/or NGOs/CSOs that are willing to partner for SBFP.
- 8.** Oversee the effective implementation of the program and prompt utilization of funds. Prepares liquidation report and submit to the SDO (after being reviewed and approved by the School Head).

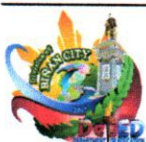

9. Collaborate with the school TWG in the conduct of monitoring and evaluation to determine its efficiency and effectiveness as well as problem areas.

13. Compiles completed Program Terminal Report and submit to the SDO as requested.



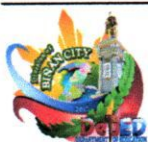
MENTAL HEALTH PROGRAM COORDINATOR

- 1.** Facilitate the creation of a School TWG for Mental Health Program (MHP).
- 2.** Prepare an Action/Annual Plan for Mental Health Program.
- 3.** Coordinate with the Division MPH Coordinator and school TWG for the provision of mental health services needed.
- 4.** Orient school personnel, parents and stakeholders regarding MPH.
- 5.** Collaborate with the school TWG in the information dissemination and advocacy campaigns, networking, and partnerships.
- 6.** Coordinate with the Division MPH Coordinator in the reporting of mental distress, anxiety or depression among learners that require prompt intervention, medical management and follow up.
- 7.** Manages and compiles record at the school in accordance with the provision of the Data Privacy Act and Data privacy Policies of DepEd.
- 8.** Participate in the seminars, trainings, capacity building for Mental Health and Psychosocial Support Services (MPHSS) among personnel and learners likewise meetings conducted by the SDO.
- 9.** Network with and engage available and interested parties; LGU's, NGOs/CSOs within the locality who shall participate in the program.
- 10.** Participate in the development of a monitoring tool that assess mental health status of personnel and learner and plan intervention based on the evaluation output.
- 11.** Provide Accomplishment Report at the end of school year to the Health & Nutrition Coordinator to be consolidated along with other OKD programs.
- 12.** Compiles completed Program Terminal Report and submit to the SDO as requested.



HEALTH SERVICES PROGRAM COORDINATOR

- 1.** Facilitate the creation of a School TWG for Health Services Program (HSP).
- 2.** Orient school personnel, parents and stakeholders regarding HSP.
- 3.** Coordinate with the Division HSP Coordinator and school TWG for the provision of health services needed.
- 4.** Prepare an Action/Annual Plan for Health Services Program (HSP).
- 5.** Participate in the capacity building, seminars, meetings conducted by the SDO.
- 6.** Collaborate with school TWG to identify and prepare the needed resources and facilities in the effective implementation of the program.
- 7.** Collaborate with the TWG in establishing records of the current health and nutritional status of the school children, situation on the health care delivery, school environment, health facilities, status of the health education activities, etc.
- 8.** Mobilize the teachers, parents, community members, partners and other stakeholders to support the program.
- 9.** Actively participate in the school health and nutrition activities by giving/health talks to different classes and grade levels.
- 10.** Oversee school clinic operation, management and record keeping at the school in accordance with the provision of the Data Privacy Act and Data privacy Policies of DepEd.
- 11.** Coordinate with other program coordinators in the provision of health services during school activities, events, and seminars.
- 12.** Assist the health personnel in conducting medical/dental check-up and nursing assessment of pupils/students.
- 13.** Coordinate with the SDO-Health Section and CHOs in the reporting of communicable diseases, refers them for proper diagnosis, management, follows up sick children, teachers, and other personnel by utilizing all possible means of communication.
- 14.** Participate in developing monitoring tool for the program implementation to provide insights in the development of action plan and funding.
- 15.** Provide Accomplishment Report at the end of school year to the Health & Nutrition Coordinator to be consolidated along with other OKD programs.
- 16.** Compiles completed Program Terminal Report and submit to the SDO as requested.



CLINIC IN CHARGE

- 1.** Participate in health and nutrition activities in collaboration with school Health Services Program (HSP) Coordinator/ school Health & Nutrition Coordinator (HNC)
 - Assist teachers as health guardians as well as helping other groups with related functions at different level.
 - Giving lectures/health talks to different classes at different grade levels and other audiences about health/nutrition topics.
 - Establish/strengthen coordination with government and non-government agencies for support/resource generation and involvement in school community health activities.
- 2.** Utilized scientifically tried and tested medicinal plants for the treatment of common ailments. Provide first aid management as required.
- 3.** Maintain functional school clinics. Required medical equipment/supplies shall be made available and accessible.
- 4.** Prepare Health examination forms (SHD Form 1) pupils/students during the National School Enrollment Day (NSED) up to September 30 of every year.
- 5.** Assist the School/assigned Nurse in conducting nursing assessment of pupils or student
 - Conduct the height and weight measurement
 - Confers with the teachers about the kind of follow-up needed by the pupils.
 - Coordinate with teachers in referring pupils/students with suspicious disabilities, special needs for further assessment/evaluation
- 6.** Promotes wholesome interpersonal relationship and hygiene practices.
- 7.** Encourages the school administrator to provide safe and sanitary health facilities.
- 8.** Render first aid treatment. Treats common ailment identified using over the counter medications.
- 9.** Isolates cases of communicable diseases and refers them to the medical officer or any health agencies for proper diagnosis and management.
- 10.** Follows-up cases of sick children, teachers, and other school personnel by utilizing all possible means of communication.
- 11.** Confers with parents/teachers concerning the health status of pupils/students.
- 12.** Prepare health communication messages/materials on the prevention and control of commonly found ailments among children which shall be communicated to the teachers during staff meetings.
- 13.** Participates in meetings/conferences/capacity building likewise in the evaluation of the school health and nutrition programs and projects.
- 14.** Prepares, consolidates, and submits required reports promptly and regularly.
